

JACOB (ISRAEL) had two wives (Leah and Rachel) and two concubines (Bilhah and Zilpah) and between the four women they produced 12 sons:

LEAH - Reuben, Simeon, Judah, Levi, Issachar and Zebulun

BILHAH - Dan and Naphtali

ZILPAH - Gad and Asher

RACHEL - Joseph and Benjamin


So far we have four (4) of the sons of Israel who were *mixed* with Hamitic and Semitic blood - Dan, Naphtali, Gad and Asher.



JUDAH

Genesis 38:1-5

"And it came to pass at that time, that Judah went down from his brethren, and turned in to a certain Adullamite, whose name was Hirah. And Judah saw there a daughter of a certain Canaanite, whose name was Shua; and he took her, and went in unto her. And she conceived, and bare a son; and he called his name Er. And she conceived again, and bare a son; and she called his name Onan. And she yet again conceived, and bare a son; and called his name Shelah."



JUDAH

The Canaanite's (Shua) daughter's name was Bathshua. By being Canaanite, she was thus a black woman. So, *Er*, *Onan and Shelah* (the sons of JUDAH) were black - Half Semitic - half Hamitic (Canaan).


Genesis 38 also tells us of another interesting story about Judah, Israel's son.

- He arranges a marriage for his son Er
- Er's wife was Tamar (a Canaanite woman)
- Judah had twin sons by Tamar: Pharez and Zerah
- THESE TWO MIXED (HAM/SHEM) SONS FORMED THE TRIBE OF JUDAH!
- Why is this so significant? What does it reveal?
- This makes the fifth (5th) tribe mixed with Hamitic (African) blood.

JOSEPH

He was thrown into a pit by his envious brothers. He was sold into slavery in Egypt (Africa). After interpreting Pharaoh's dream, he was not only released from prison but became second in command in all of Egypt.

During his glory years in Egypt, Pharaoh (an Egyptian king) gave Joseph a wife to marry. She was an Egyptian (Mizraim/Black, African) woman named <u>Asenath</u>, the daughter of Potipherah priest of On (Gen 41:45).



JOSEPH

Together Joseph and Asenath had two sons. Their names are Manasseh and Ephraim (Genesis 41:50-52). Manasseh and Ephraim were mixed with Hamitic and Semitic blood. They were counted as two separate tribes and were given land allotments when they entered into the Promise Land. This makes a total of 7 out of 12 tribes that were mixed with Hamitic and Semitic blood.

Joseph (and his brothers died), Israel became fruitful and multiplied and became exceedingly mighty. "And the land (of Egypt - Africa) was filled with them" (Exodus 1:7).

ISRAELITES

Israel went into Egypt as a family (70 people) and came out of Egypt as a nation (Estimated 2-2.5 million people). The nation of Israel was birthed in Africa.

God raised up a deliverer name Moses (a Levite). He was raised up in the palace of Pharaoh (a black man/ Hamitic) but Moses himself was Hebrew (Ivri or Everh). Why couldn't Pharaoh immediately identify Moses apart from his own people?



Before Moses' death, he appointed a successor to lead the Israelites into the Promise Land. His name was "Oshea the son of Nun," better known as Joshua.

He was from the tribe of Ephraim. Again, Ephraim was half Hebrew (Ivri or Everh) (Semitic) and half Egyptian (Hamitic). This means that Joshua was also a black man.



JUDAH

Why is the story of Judah and Tamar important?

Matthew 1:1-3

"The book of the generation of JESUS CHRIST, the son of David, the son of Abraham.


Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judah and his brethren; AND JUDAH begat PHARES and ZARA of THAMAR..."

Does this prove that Jesus (Yeshua) of Nazareth was a person with a good amount of melanin in His skin?

Five generations later from Phares, his great grandson, Salmon, marries a woman from Jericho name RAHAB (THE CANAANITE WOMAN who helped Joshua and the two spies).

They had a son name, Boaz, whose grandson, Jesse, was king David's father.




So where did the paintings of a "White" Jesus come from?










Salvator Mundi or "Savior of the World" (Early 1500's AD - DaVinci)


WHITE JESUS FROM 1500 AD - PRESENT DAY









Earliest known painting of **YESHUA (JESUS)** and His apostles in Coptic Museum in Cairo, Egypt. (Before 6th Century AD)






Jesus Appearing through the Closed Door Painting by Duccio-di-Buoninsegna in 1308
